

Care and Cleaning Instructions

Powder coated mild steel

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth.
- Suitable for regular detergents.

Oiled timber surfaces

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth.
- Avoid using regular detergents as this will strip the wood of its natural oils, leaving it unprotected.
- To maintain the timber surface, we recommend regular applications of the maintenance spray provided (mix of ProNature plant based soap and water).
- As per the instructions on the maintenance spray, apply as follows:
 - Wipe surface clean with a dry cloth
 - Shake bottle well
 - Spray directly onto the surface
 - Wipe down with a damp cloth
 - Allow to dry

Varnished surfaces

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth.
- Suitable for regular detergents.

Oiled Garapa Hardwood

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth.
- Avoid using regular detergents as this will strip the wood of its natural oils.
- If you want to maintain the new colour, re-oil regularly by wiping a 1:1 mix of turpentine and linseed oil onto the timber surface.
- Allowed to weather, the timber will turn a silver grey colour over time. This is the timber's natural aging process.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE

Acclimatization to dryer environments

- To ensure that the timber furniture adjusts from the conditions in our factory in the Cape to the dryer conditions inland or in an air-conditioned facility, each piece of timber furniture must be wiped down with a wet cloth every day for a full month following installation – top and bottom. It doesn't have to be done neatly, but the timber requires the moisture during that period to adjust (expand and contract) to a new environment without cracking.
